

CHILDREN

5 Years and Under

Babysitting and activities are provided during the morning and evening meetings. Parents with children using the nursery will be scheduled to help at least once during the conference. The schedule is made prior to the conference.

1st-6th Grades

Classes and activities are provided during the morning and afternoon meetings, except on Sunday. For those interested, a story-hour is provided Thursday through Saturday evenings. Children will be dismissed from the meeting after worship just before the ministry of the word.

Junior High/High School

Junior High and High School young people are required to attend either the morning youth or ministry meeting. Attendance at both the afternoon youth and evening ministry meetings are required.

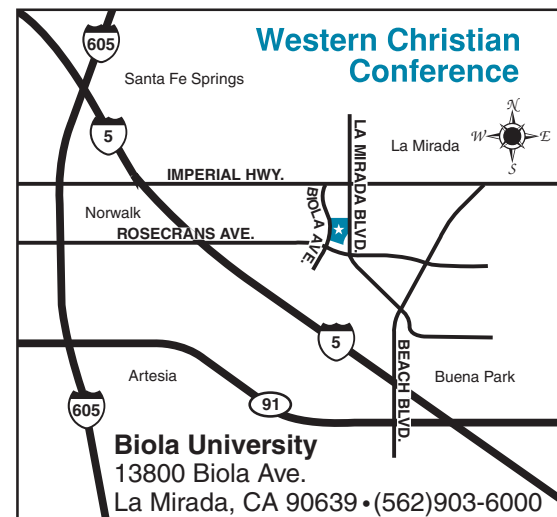


REGISTRATION

DRIVING FROM LOS ANGELES OR SAN FRANCISCO

- Take Interstate 5 south.
- Get off at Rosecrans Ave. toward La Mirada and go east (right turn).
- Take Rosecrans Ave. to La Mirada Blvd, make a left (north).
- Make a left into BIOLA University at the hanging bell.

DRIVING FROM SAN DIEGO

- Take Interstate 5 north toward Los Angeles
- Continue on Interstate 5 north through Orange County, off at Beach Blvd in Buena Park, go north.
- Take Beach Blvd to La Mirada Blvd, make a left
- BIOLA University is located approx. 3 miles on the left. Make a left into the campus at the hanging bell.

DRIVING FROM ARIZONA

- Take Interstate 40 west to CA. Take Interstate 15 south to 60 west and 57 south.
- Get off on Imperial Hwy. and go west or right.
- Turn left on La Mirada Blvd., then right into BIOLA at the hanging bell.
